Summary of Testing Methods and Key Findings

Testing for the 170.315(g)(7), (g)(9), and (g)(10) criteria was performed in our pre-production environment. We used test patient data and ran simulated workflows to confirm that the API functions behaved as expected. ONC C-CDA validation tools were used to verify the results and accuracy of the CDA data involved. Overall, the testing confirmed that the certified capabilities continue to operate correctly, even though they are not currently deployed to customers.

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Patient Chart Manager EHR supports ambulatory medical clinics, and testing for this measure took place in the ambulatory care setting.

Standardized API for Patient and Population Services

Description	<p>Prime Clinical FHIR API allows other health IT applications to make read-only requests for patient health information included in USCDI v1.</p> <p>The API supports patient identification, category-based data requests, and full patient data requests, as required under 170.315(g)(7), 170.315(g)(9), and 170.315(g)(10).</p> <p>If in use, this measure would track clients registered for the use of FHIR resources, with activity monitored through the registered user’s log. During testing, a report would be generated covering the entire year to identify the number of times patient data was accessed by registered clients.</p>

Outcome	<p>No customers are currently using these certified API capabilities, and no requests for access were received during the reporting period. Because no clients were registered for the use of FHIR resources, the registered user’s log contained no entries and no patient data access events. To assess compliance, internal testing was performed using test patient data in a pre-production environment.</p> <p>Test scenarios included populating data, exporting CDA files, and validating them using ONC C-CDA validation tools and the Inferno test tools for 170.315(g)(10).</p> <p>These simulated tests, including Inferno validation for (g)(10), confirmed that the system continues to meet all required certification criteria, even without real-world utilization.</p>
